Our Tyler Roth/WKVI Athlete of the Week for this week is Josh Anderson, a member of the Football team at John Glenn High School.

Josh carried the ball 16 times for 206 yards and 2 touchdowns as the Falcons beat Culver 43-14 in a Northern State Conference game. His 12.9 yards per carry average was helped by a 77 yard run as the Falcons won their fifth game in their last 6 outings.

Just a Sophomore, the 5-11, 170 pound wingback is one of a trio of backs which includes Seniors Tyler Thornton and Kevin Stewart that have become the scourge of the Conference.
