

**TYLER ROTH/WKVI ATHLETE OF THE WEEK (02/20/10)**

**Our Tyler Roth/WKVI Athlete of the Week for this week is Jordan Brandt, a member of the Girls Basketball team at Winamac High School.**

**Jordan led her team to their third Sectional championship in her 4 years as a Varsity starter with outstanding scoring, ballhandling, defense and over-all leadership.**

**The 5-5 Senior was held scoreless from the field in the opening 53-42 win over Culver, but hit 9 of 10 free throws as the Warriors gained revenge for an early season loss to the Lady Cavaliers. In addition, she pulled down 6 rebounds, handed out 4 assists and came up with 3 steals.**

**In the snow-delayed second game, she poured in 19 points, hauled in 7 rebounds, dished out 4 assists and had 4 steals as the Lady Warriors beat North Newton 57-46.**

**But, it was her spectacular play in the Championship game upset of 4th-ranked Boone Grove that left fans dazzled as she ripped the nets for 20 points, grabbed 9 rebounds, gave out 5 assists and swiped 3 steals that sealed the deal for the underdog Warriors in a 50-33 drubbing of the previously once-beaten Lady Wolves. In addition, her speed, energy and Senior leadership rose to the top. In one dramatic trip down court, two opponents were literally left lying on the floor as she drove by them with a dribbling exhibition that could only be described as “Unbelievable”!**
