

WKVI's 2012 Spring Tour

WASHINGTON, D.C. & GETTYSBURG BATTLEFIELD

Tours of Memorials - US Capitol - Mount Vernon - National Cathedral
June 14-18, 2011 5 days - 4 nights

After an early morning departure from the WKVI Radio Studios on our *Deluxe Cardinal Motor Coach* we travel to *Gettysburg, PA* for an included dinner at the *Farnsworth House Inn*, one of the most historic buildings in Gettysburg. We expect a visit from *Mr. Lincoln (Historical Interpreter)* and then overnight Thursday at the *Courtyard by Marriott Gettysburg*.

Friday, after an included full breakfast at the hotel, we visit *Gettysburg Battlefield*. The battle there was a turning point in the Civil War. The Union victory ended General Robert E. Lee's second and most ambitious invasion of the North in 1863. *Civil War Historian and History instructor at the Knox Middle School, Alan Selge, will personally guide us through Historic Gettysburg Battlefield and Gettysburg National Cemetery*, sharing intimate details of the battle. Included Italian family-style dinner tonight at *Carmines Restaurant in Washington, D. C.* Night tour of *Memorials*, including *WWII, Korean War and Lincoln Memorial*. Our first of three nights in Washington will be at the *New Renaissance Marriott Capital View Hotel*.

Saturday, after an included *Deluxe Continental* breakfast at the hotel, we travel to the *U.S. Capitol* for a scheduled tour of one the most recognizable symbols of representative democracy in the world ---- bring sure to bring a photo ID -- then on to *Mount Vernon Inn* for an included lunch, followed by a tour of the *Mount Vernon Plantation*, on the banks of the *Potomac River*, the home of our first President, *George Washington*. Then on to *Alexandria, Virginia*, with time to browse the shops as you stroll the 250-year-old brick--paved streets lined with 18th and 19th century architecture. You can choose to have your dinner, on your own, at one of the award-winning restaurants, many of which are owned and operated by local chefs. This evening we will attend *American Musical Landscapes at the George Washington Memorial*, a multimedia tour of American music, places, history and culture. We return to our hotel after the presentation.

Sunday's exciting schedule >>>>

Sunday morning, after the included Deluxe Continental breakfast at the hotel, we'll attend the 8:30 *Worship Service* at the *National Cathedral*. The second largest cathedral in the United States, construction began in 1907 with President Theodore Roosevelt in attendance and was completed in 1990 with President George H. Bush in attendance. State funerals were held there for presidents Woodrow Wilson, 1924; Dwight Eisenhower, 1969; Ronald Reagan, 2004; and Gerald Ford, 2007. The cathedral was damaged during the 2011 Virginia earthquake and it was closed for several months afterward. The annual Christmas service at the cathedral has been broadcast to the nation on television since 1953. The organ has 10,647 pipes. It is one of the largest in the world. We'll have lunch on our own today and then visit the *National Archives*. You'll see the *United States Government's Charters of Freedom*, the *U.S. Constitution*, the *Bill of Rights*, and the *Declaration of Independence*.

Sunday afternoon we stop at *Arlington National Cemetery*, a resting place for veterans including those who fought in the Civil War. We'll see the *Tomb of the Unknowns*, the *Kennedy Graves*, and other locations throughout the 624 acres of the cemetery. The impressive landscape serves as a tribute to the service and the sacrifice of every individual laid to rest within the hallowed ground of the Arlington National Cemetery. On our way for our included evening meal at *Madam Tussauds*, we'll make a stop for pictures of the *White House*. Madam Tussauds Wax Museum is the only place in the world you can have your picture taken with all 43 Presidents and in an exact replica of the White House's *Oval Office*. See perfect representations of world famous personalities and icons. Then its back to our comfortable hotel.

Monday morning, after the included Deluxe Continental breakfast at the hotel, we'll visit the *FDR* and the *Jefferson Memorials*. Before we depart for home we'll travel to *Embassy Row* and a visit to an *Embassy*. We'll be back in Knox late Monday night, June 18th.
