## **CEMETERY RULES**

- 1. No stakes, flags, posts, fences, or any other enclosures permitted on any grave.
- 2. No grave mounds (lots/graves raised above established grade).
- 3. No ground cover other than grass permitted on lots/graves.
- 4. Watering permitted only during posted hours, must be attended, and watering equipment must be removed from cemetery at the end of watering.
- 5. No decorations or plantings of any kind shall be placed on the west side of any foundation in order to main public walkways.
- 6. All natural and artificial flowers must be in a container or planter within 12" of the monument/marker foundation edge and within the grave/lot boundary.
- 7. Permanent plantings are restricted to those of a dwarf nature and must be placed within twelve (12) inches of the grave or lot's monument or marker foundation edge and within the lot or grave boundary.
- 8. No trees, bushes, or shrubs may be planted.
- 9. Grave blankets are permitted between November 1 of given year and March 1<sup>st</sup> of subsequent year.
- 10. Spring cleanup will be posted prior to the removal of any temporary decorations.

Violations of these rules are subject to fines as defined in the Town Ordinance. A complete copy of the Cemetery Rules and Regulations adopted in 1959, revised February, 2013, is available at the Clerk-Treasurer's office.
