Tulip Festival - Holland, Michigan

4 days, 3 nights -- May 4-7, 2015

Depart WKVI Radio Studios on our Cardinal Motor Coach mid-morning. We'll enjoy an inside look at Holland and the Tulip Festival. The number one attraction is the tulips themselves, over 5,000,000 city-wide. Named the "Best Small Town Festival" by Reader's Digest.

At the Wooden Shoe and Delft Factory you can talk with the artists as they hand carve your very own wooden shoes or hand paint blue and white delftware. Dancers perform old-world style Dutch dances in authentic turn-of-the-century costumes and wooden shoes.

Reserved seats for Dinner Theatre - "Three Guys, Thirty Instruments!" Family friendly and energetic. Comedy, skits, music. They play a lot of the oldies.

Windmill Island Gardens. A beautiful oasis on the edge of downtown Holland, the gardens feature 36 acres of manicured gardens, (home to 150,000 tulips), dikes, canals and walking paths. Featuring a nearly 250-year-old working Dutch windmill, an antique Dutch carousel and an Amsterdam street organ.

We have reserved seats for "Dazzle" -- a musical collage on four stages with full festival orchestra, jazz band, and show choirs.

Visit the Henry Ford Museum. A remarkable destination that brings American ideas and innovations to life. The sweeping, single-floor space with soaring 40-ft ceilings covers nine acres dedicated to showcasing the finest collection of its kind ever assembled.

Tour and Dinner at the home of Auto Baron Edsel Ford. We'll experience the story of the Ford family in this historic mansion with art and antiques. The estate stands amid 87 acres of beautifully landscaped gardens and grounds. Gift shop.

The Ford Rouge Factory Experience is comprised of theatre presentations and a walking tour above the actual final assembly area where Ford F-150's are made.
