

LOCAL EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

Pulaski County, Indiana
June 19, 2015

AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, Pulaski County, Indiana has been impacted by a natural hazard as follows:

On Friday, June 19, 2015 at 12:00 P.M. EST (11:00 a.m. CST) a county-wide severe flooding emergency was declared by the Pulaski County Board of Commissioners. This flood emergency hazard will remain in effect until such time the Commissioners evaluate the hazard to be ended. All county roads are hazardous and impassable due to high waters. Due to flooding waters it has been determined hazardous. Caution should be taken.

NOW, THEREFORE WE, the Pulaski County Board of Commissioners, declare that the state of emergency exists in Pulaski County and that we hereby invoke and declare those portions of the Indiana Code which are applicable to the conditions and have caused the issuance of this proclamation, to be in full force and effect in the county for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for the protection of the lives and property of the people of Pulaski County and the restoration of local government with a minimum of interruption. All activities should be approached with extreme caution.

Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances, and resolutions, and particularly to section 10-14-3-7 of the Indiana Code.


All public offices and employees of Pulaski County are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of duties required of them for the duration of the emergency and in execution of emergency laws, regulations, and directives-state and local.


All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials and disaster services forces in executing emergency operations plans, and to obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.


All operating forces will direct their communications and requests for assistance and operations directly to the Pulaski County Emergency 911 Center.


